THE EQUAL ACCESS LOAN – PORTFOLIO REPORT AUGUST 2022

- The Equal Access Loan is an interest-free, character-based financial product available to those with refugee status throughout the UK who require UK accreditation in order to return to work in the UK.The loan is offered to:
- Those with refugee status in the UK
- Individuals who require financial support to sit UK accreditation exams.
- People who intend to work in the same field as they worked in in their home country.
- People who have already achieved the required level of English Language (if applicants haven't, they're referred to our English Language programme https://refuaid.org/language)
- Each successful loan applicant has a personalised repayment schedule and a dedicated caseworker who supports them on their UK reaccreditation journey.

As it involves considerable cost, I was just looking for funding options and then I read about RefuAid. It just took two to three conversations amongst us and subsequently they approved a loan for me (of course when I give evidence of my qualifications and experience) which was sufficient for my exam cost and materials. Then comes the COVID however I passed my exams with flying colours as I was awarded distinction . I am currently employed by a renowned academic and health care institution in a cancer prevention and screening project. Thanks RefuAid for all your help and support. 




The Equal Access Loan

We have now made loans totaling £1,574,864.90 to 283 individuals.

The average loan amount is currently £5564.88.







GREETINGS, I AM A SYRIAN REFUGEE DOCTOR. I CAME TO THE UNITED KINGDOM IN 2019. AS AN INTERNATIONAL MEDICAL GRADUATE I WAS ASKED TO PASS CERTAIN EXAMS IN ORDER TO OBTAIN THE LICENSE TO PRACTICE AS A DOCTOR

I WAS A LITTLE BIT FRUSTRATED WITH AN UNDERSTANDABLY LONG PROCESS FOR APPLYING FOR MY LICENSE TO PRACTICE. BEING A REFUGEE AWAY FROM HOME AND FAMILY IS A UNIQUE EXPERIENCE, ALTHOUGH I WAS ALONE AND AWAY FROM MY FAMILY AND FRIENDS WITH NO EMOTIONAL OR FINANCIAL SUPPORT, I WAS ABLE TO FIND PEOPLE HERE IN THE UK THAT HELPED ME THROUGH TOUGH TIMES. REFUAID WAS AN ESSENTIAL HELPLINE FOR ME AND WITH THEIR AID I WAS ABLE TO GET SOME OF THE RESOURCES NEEDED

I AM PROFOUNDLY GRATEFUL FOR REFUAID ORGANISATION HELP AND I BELIEVE IT IS A WISE DECISION TO HELP PEOPLE IN NEED, THEIR HELP ALLOWED ME TO PROGRESS FURTHER IN MY CAREER WHICH I HOPE WILL BE REFLECTED AS A BETTER QUALITY OF CARE IN ANY HEALTH CARE INSTITUTION I WILL BE PART OF IN THE FUTURE. MY HOPE IS THAT AS I ADVANCE IN MY CAREER I CAN USE MY SKILLS AND EXPERIENCE TO BENEFIT THE SOCIETY AND THE COUNTRY THAT GAVE ME A NEW LIFE, THE UNITED KINGDOM. I AM CURRENTLY WORKING AS A MEDICAL SUPPORT WORKER (BAND 6) AT THE ROYAL LONDON HOSPITAL AND ALSO PREPARING FOR THE PLAB EXAM.

WITHOUT REFUAID HELP AND SUPPORT, IT WOULD HAVE BEEN MUCH HARDER FOR ME TO BE WHERE I AM NOW. I AM HAPPY AND PROUD THAT NOW I AM A PART OF THE NHS. I HOPE I CAN GET THE LICENSE TO PRACTICE AS SOON AS POSSIBLE TO BEGIN MY JOURNEY AS A DOCTOR IN THIS COUNTRY AND I HOPE THE BEST FOR ALL PEOPLE WHOSE SITUATION IS SIMILAR TO MINE."





The Equal Access Loan - Client Demographics

Of the 283 loan clients the majority come from Syria, Sudan and Iran. In recent months we have seen an increase in applications from people from Afghanistan and we are now beginning to see applicants from Ukraine, although we expect a delay on Ukrainian applicants as most people will spend time on our language programme prior to needing the loan. We are now supporting more women than prior to 2020 when the loan portfolio only had 25% women and we are continuing our female engagement strategies to make sure the loan is equally accessible.





The Equal Access Loan – Repayments

Loan - Status Repaying Lent Repaid Suspended Delinguent 188 loan recipients are currently repaying the agreed monthly amount.71 clients are currently on an agreed capital repayment holiday. 20clients have fully repaid their loans and 4 loans remain suspended.




The Equal Access Loan – Repayments

> Each loan recipient's repayment schedule is different. Some people have a set capital repayment holiday, others start repaying straight away.










The Equal Access Loan – Employment & Tax Contributions



Of the 283 Loan recipients 135 are now in work commensurate with their skills and experience. The **average salary for loan recipients once in work is £33,489**. The average pre-loan income is £5970. <u>78% of loan</u> **applicants are in receipt of Universal Credit when they apply.**



The 135 loan clients who are now working commensurate with skills and experience <u>are now contributing</u> ^c <u>£970,036 per annum in tax to the UK economy.</u> As more clients complete their learning pathways we expect ^s this to grow.




